BEST PRACTICES OF Dr GR PUBLIC SCHOOL

We conduct Inter religious prayer on all Fridays, in order to promote spirituality and religious tolerance.

Students wear White Khadi Uniform on all Fridays and other special occasion of school. We proudly declare that the only school in India use khadi as uniform is our school. Staff also use Khadi on all Fridays and special days.

Daily meditation for class XI and XII students is another highlight of our school. Meditation is the reservoir of mind power, which help all children to shine like stars in every walk of lives.

Class XII students are attending regular daily test papers, which enable them write the exam well.

Our children greet everyone in the school with "JAI HIND" which always reminds us of our motherland.

Special assembly for two days: As CBSE promotes art integrated education and giving importance for all forms of arts, we give chances to all children to present their performance during special assembly of 40 minutes with a unique theme.

MASS DRILL: Twice in every week whole school will be assembled in the ground for mass drill as a part of physical and health education program.

School Cabinet is formed to promote and nurture leadership quality and mould children into future leaders.

Let me present the Academic Excellence of our school.

By the Grace of God we achieved meritorious 100% result and placed number one position in Neyyattinkara Taluk. Our teachers indeed they deserve great appreciation as they are regularly bringing wonderful results by their strenuous hard work and meticulous planning and training the children. In class XII, 71 students appeared. 12 students secured above 95%, 18 students secured above 90% and 41 students secured above 75%. Scoring 97.2 % MERLIN FREDDY became the school topper and she cleared NEET exam securing all India Rank 20000 and 3rd Rank in community base. In Kerala Entrance (KEAM) she secured 2900th rank.

9 students secured 100 marks in Physical Education and 3 students secured 99 marks in Malayalam. 41 students in English, 22 students in Biology, 13 students in Physics, 10 students in Malayalam and 9 students in Chemistry secured 90% and above.

In class X 136 students appeared. ABHIJITH A S secured 7th RANK IN ALL INDIA LEVEL, with 98.4 %. 9 students secured 100 marks in SOCIAL SCIENCE and 4 students secured 100 marks in MATHEMATICS. 96 students secured 90% and above in Social Science, 66 in English, 53 in Science, 43 in Maths, 40 in Malayalam and 33 in Hindi. Sister blessed all teachers of classes 10

and 12 with cash award. Students and Teachers attended the SOUTH ZONE SAHODAYA AWARD CEREMONY and received Merit certificates and cash Awards. AS TOKEN OF OUR LOVE LET US ALL GIVE A ROUND OF APPLAUSE FOR ALL THE TEACHERS.

Our school secured overall 3rd position in South Zone Sahodaya Science Exhibition and 1st position in Category I and second runner up in cat. III.

It was a matter of pride to us yet again, when Akshith k Ajith of class V was honoured with Karmasreshta Award 2018 for the upcoming singer on 14th Nov by Sangam Kala group Tvm. He was selected to sing the welcome song on the occasion of Children's Day Celebration at TVM in the Presence of the Hon. Governor and the Ministers. He had the privilege to be one among the special invitees to dine with Governor on the Republic day at his bungalow.

Students participated in the Robotics competition, conducted by Trinity College of Engineering, TVM. and secured 2nd position and awarded with a cash prize of RS 5000/-. Kumari sreya Aneesh of class VII got qualified for the Deen Dayal Sparsh Yojana Scholarship 2018-19 from Postal Department of India. Our students Krishna Nanda and Anoop Sankar of class VIII were the KALATHILAKAM and KALAPRATHIBHA respectively in the FRAN kaloltsav.

Kum. Vidyavathy of class VI selected as the BEST CHILD ACTOR in the Swatch short film festival organized by Ministry of Environment and Forest, Govt. of India. Kum. Aiswarya of class 6 secured the 2nd Rank in ALL KERALA SUGAMA HINDI EXAMINATION and our School secured the 2nd position in District and State Level for maximum participation. Kum. Ananya Beena of class 8th secured National Level 2nd Prize in Letter Writing competition conducted by Postal Dept. of India.

Students who got A+ in all subjects in both X and XII Board Exam were appreciated and awarded by the Hon. Educational Minister K T Jaleel at "MIKAVU -2019", organized by Mr K Ansalan MLA. of Neyyattinkara.

We are conducting various EVENTS RELATED TO 150TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS OF MAHATMA GANDHI.

2018 Art Fest Aanandam was with the theme of Gandhian Thoughts and all competitions were with topics related to Gandhiji. "Vahana Pracharana Jatha" which was organized by kerala Sarvodaya Mandalam to commemorate Mahatma Gandhi and Kasthurba's 150th anniversary was flagged off by Padmasri Sri P Gopinathan Nair from Dr G R's Smriti Mandir. Students and teachers along with Sister and Principal participated a protest meeting -"MAHATHMAVE MAPPU" organized by all Gandhian organizations at Secretariat Tvm on 1st February, in connection with demeaning and mortifying Gandhiji on Martyrs day.

As a special program on Spreading the message of Gandhiji, Sister Mythili gifted Gandhiji's auto biography, "The story of My Experiments with Truth" to all children of our school. Celebration of Gandhiji's 150th birthday was organized by Gandhian Bala Kendrangal, which was hosted in our school, and inaugurated by the Hon. Tourism and Devasam Board Minister Kadakampalli Surendran. Sister Mythili was the Special Guest. Students from 90 schools attended the program.

New Additions

Now we have installed 47 ICR smart classes with wifi and internet facility. We purchased 3 new school buses as per the request of procurement manger Mr Hemanth. Staff vehicle parking shed has been set up. Solar project for the school has been initiated. More than 100 cameras have been installed to make sure all children are safe and secure. 250 KV Transformer for our campus is another addition. Kalabhavan has been renovated and converted as the Board room. New app for parents to access all activity of every child is great boon. All school buses are fitted with GPS tracking device for better security.

TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAMME

Orientation programs for teachers are regularly conducted in our school. SRI T P Sreenivasan, IFS, had inspired all teachers and all are grateful to him for his motivation. On that occasion homage was paid to former trust member, late, Prof. Madhav Menon.

In-service training for all teachers by CBSE COE was conducted on 'Life Skills' and 'Remodelled Assessment'.

ICR refreshment course for teachers was conducted.

Principal and teachers attended the "Principal-Teachers Workshop" on "Art Integrated Learning" at hotel SP Grand Days, TVM.

Two Days Mathematics workshop (Capacity Building Program) for Maths teachers of class IX & X by CBSE - COE was hosted by our school.

Other Activities

Prestigious Sahodaya Art and literary fest was hosted by our school wherein 5500 participation reported and the event lasted for 3 days. Chief guest Mr Sarathappani inaugurated the art fest. Special committee was formed and all people were very cordial and cooperative which made the event a grand success.

The School Art and Literary Fest, Aanandam was inaugurated by Mr Senthil Krishna, Cini Artist who inspired and captured the children with his magical skills of music and humour.

NSS CAMP is a unique feature of our school and we are proud that we are the only active unit of NSS in CBSE and students get life skill basic trainings in the camp.

All students are divided into different Clubs and Activities of the clubs give students different exposure and Philately club is being monitored by the Postal dept. of India and various inter-school activities are being organized.

School Management Committee meeting was conducted on 2nd Oct. This meeting is a very important meeting as it is before the inspection for affiliation renewal process. We have got two KV principals as CBSE nominees and new panel has been nominated for SMC as per new byelaw. Lots of innovative inputs received from the members and new PTA byelaw has been given for discussion and approved by the SMC. Board Nominees and members gave valuable suggestion to make PTA effective and positive. KV Principals agreed for resource exchange and internship programs. They were of high regard of our school. There were few suggestions to have Class PTM on working Saturday to come with their ward to meet teachers and to get feedbacks. AEP classes were also recommended by the members. Students should be taken to field trips to old age home and special homes.

School Cabinet

An election for selecting school Head boy, Head girl and other members of the school cabinet was conducted and it was a milestone as online digital election was conducted for the first time in our school. "MEET THE CANDIDATE" campaign for the election was very effective and students were allowed for individual campaign in class rooms also. Head Boy, Head Girl, Asst. Head Boy, Asst. Head Girl and 27 Cabinet members in HS Section and 18 Cabinet Members in Primary Section were selected. Investiture Ceremony was conducted on 12th July and Cabinet members assumed different post in that occasion.

Remedial classes

Remedial classes for 10 std students, who secured less marks, were arranged in the evening; 2 days Maths, 2 days Science and one day Social Science. From 10th of October we are going to give special coaching classes for class X and XII students who aspire to achieve greater heights. For class XII daily test paper has been arranged systematically and regularly.

Before I conclude, I would like to mention the awards and honours bestowed on our Sister Mythili recently. On the auspicious occasion of International Women's Day Sister was given "Best Social Worker Award" by Women and Child Welfare Dept of Kerala and "Vanitha Ratnam Award" by Asreya-Karinada. She is also the recipient of KASTHURBA GANDHI PURASKAR FROM Gandhigram Rural University Aluminai. We wish her good health and May the Lord our God shower her all his blessings to lead this institution to greater heights and serve the humanity.
